



## *On the Day of Your Five Rivers Visit*



As with any trip, a check of important items before departure helps you feel prepared. Please take a moment to review that you and your students are prepared for a wonderful day at Five Rivers.

### **AT SCHOOL:**

- Restrooms have been visited.
- Name tags have been prepared and ready to be handed out to all students and adults.
- Groups have been assigned.
- Student Medication has been given to the adult chaperone responsible for the student during the visit.
- Cell phones have been muted or turned off.
- Visitor Guidelines have been discussed.
  - 🍷 Five Rivers is a nature sanctuary. We will respect all parts of the environment during our visit, especially when examining and handling plants and wildlife. When your lesson is finished, please continue in this spirit. Do not disturb wildlife or pick/collect any items here at Five Rivers.
  - 🍷 Smoking and littering are strictly prohibited.
  - 🍷 Use caution when crossing the parking lot or nearby roads.
  - 🍷 Enjoy the natural setting of Five Rivers keeping in mind that others are here doing the same.
- Snacks, lunches and garbage bags have been packed. Five Rivers is a carry in, carry out facility.
- Insect repellent has **NOT** been used on hands, forearms or legs.

### **CHECK-IN:**

- 🍷 Arrive promptly at the scheduled check-in time. Note that this is 15 minutes before your lesson begins.
- 🍷 Enter through the BUS ENTRANCE and the GSP Coordinator will greet you and assign instructors.

### **AFTER THE LESSON:**

- 🍷 All groups are welcome to visit our hands-on exhibits and bird watching area in the Visitor Center!
- 🍷 Stay and have lunch outside if you like. **We are a carry in/carry out facility** so please bring a garbage bag for your trash and remember to take it back to school with you. You will need to provide your own lunch and drinks as we do not have drinking fountains or a snack bar. During inclement weather, your group may use our indoor area to eat **if** it is available.
