Happy Birthday Geocaching! Twenty years ago outdoor enthusiasts were introduced to a treasure hunt called Geocaching. Using Global Positioning Systems (GPS units), people home in on the location of a treasure or cache and record their “find”. To date, more than 426 million people have “Found It” in over 191 countries on all 7 continents. With more than 3 million caches out there to find, it’s time you joined the fun.

Five Rivers has more than 20 caches for us to find together. First, we will learn how to program cache locations using hand held GPS units. Then, we’ll head out to search for the treasure while enjoying a nature walk. Finally, we’ll report “Found It” to the world and provide hints for the next treasure hunter.
