

Friends' Guided School Program





PRE-VISIT MATERIALS: Download and use detailed preparatory lesson plans and chaperone guidelines found on Friends of Five Rivers' website. (www.FriendsofFiveRivers.org).
NAME TAGS: Make student and chaperone name tags. Name tags are mandatory for all visitors.
 STUDENT GROUPS: Create groups of up to 15 students maximum with 2 chaperones minimum.
 MEDICATIONS: Work with school nurse to prepare and divide student medication. Medications must be carried by an adult in the child's group. Adult must know how to administer medication(s).
 SPECIAL NEEDS : Notify Friends of Five Rivers of any special needs your students may have, including but not limited to mobility issues and allergies (especially nut allergies).
 CLOTHING: Dress for the weather. Classes are held outside unless it starts to thunder/lightning.
 CHAPERONES: Inform chaperones of their responsibilities, including student discipline. Ask chaperones to turn off their cell phones or put them on vibrate for the duration of the lesson.
 SNACKS: Bring a snack if the students will miss a regularly scheduled snack or lunch time. Let the GSP Coordinator know you need a snack break and one will be planned for you.
VISITOR GUIDELINES: Discuss these points with students and chaperones prior to your visit.
 Five Rivers is a nature sanctuary. We will respect all parts of the environment during your visit, especially when examining and handling plants and wildlife. Leave no trace of your visit. Smoking and littering are strictly prohibited. Use caution when crossing the parking lot or nearby roads.

CHECK-IN: Arrive promptly at your scheduled check-in time. Enter through the BUS ENTRANCE. The Director of Programs, Nancy Conway, will greet you at the roundabout.
