# **BOARD PRESIDENT – RANDY COBURN**

## Board President - Randy Coburn

The 2019-20 fiscal year began like any other. Summer Family Fun, Honey Bees and Beekeeping, Fall Festival, Guided School Programs, Family Fun and Talk and Trek all churning along nicely.

As we celebrated the New Year, winter events were held and planning for the Guided School Program and other spring programs were on schedule. The Center was open and volunteer greeters were welcoming and engaging visitors to enhance their experience at the Center. We had every reason to think it would be another great year of quality environmental education at Five Rivers.

And then the world changed.

COVID-19 was that jolting change. The Center closed and all programming was cancelled in the Spring. Revenues from the Guided School Program all but disappeared.

Joanne Macklin retired as Executive Director after many years of great accomplishments. Her leadership and commitment to Five Rivers have been missed. The Executive Committee stepped up to fill the void and keep things as normal as possible.

Board meetings are being hosted via technology provided by DEC. Committee meetings are done over Zoom or conference calls. We continue to transition to a virtual environment to enable administrative tasks to be completed online.

Our environmental educators, Nancy Conway, Nancy Payne and Alex Garrigan-Piela, devised new ways to provide hands-on education safely and cost-effectively. Training for volunteer instructors continued. Programs continued to be developed and programming restarted in July.

Parks and Trails NY provided us a one-year grant to help build capacity for outreach and development. Carolyn Dunn was retained to devise a plan of action and has since been hired as our Development and Outreach Coordinator to sustain focus on our development goals. Many thanks to her for stepping up and working hard to fully engage our friends, organize events, communicate the impact of our programs, and hopefully increase our financial support.

Friends of Five Rivers was successful in securing a small business loan under the Payment Protection Program to enable us to retain our staff during the crisis. We have already applied to the Small Business Administration for conversion of the loan to a grant and are confident we meet all the criteria for this to happen.

# TREASURER'S REPORT – DAN BERRY

## Treasurer's Report - Dan Berry

The Friends' Financial Reports, including the IRS 2019 Return (Form 990) and the NYS Annual Financial Report for Charitable Organizations (CHAR500), prepared by an independent accountant, are available to the public. Following is a summary of the Friends' financial performance fiscal year ending June 30, 2020.

#### **OVERALL PICTURE**

Operational revenue and spending increased in the current year with revenue fortunately outpacing expenses by \$2,822. Overall, total revenue as reported in the IRS 990 increased over the prior year by \$37,976 to \$202,987, while total spending increased by \$20,837 to \$200,165.

### BREAKDOWN OF OPERATING REVENUE

The largest sources of operating revenue at 38% each were from government grants (\$77,081) followed closely by non-government grants and donations at 36% (\$72,782). Paid membership dues of \$29,026 accounted for 14% of total operating revenue, consistent with the \$29,676 in membership dues received the prior year. Program fee revenue at 9% increased from \$15,119 the prior year to \$18,114 despite the necessary cancellation of nearly all spring Guided School Program lessons but fell short of budget projections by \$7,655. The remaining 3% of revenue totaling \$5,984 came from bookstore sales and other ancillary sources.

#### **BREAKDOWN OF SPENDING**


Program expenses of \$166,031 accounting for 83% of total spending, was appropriately the largest area of spending and a \$1,806 increase over the prior year. Fundraising expenses at 9% accounted for the second largest area of spending at \$18,695, a dramatic increase over the 1% spent on fundraising in prior years. Management and administration accounted for the remaining \$15,439 or 8%, consistent with the prior year.


The large increase in the proportion of spending on fundraising was driven by the Board's decision to add a full-time Development and Outreach Coordinator to the staff to increase focus in those areas, particularly fundraising. With funding obtained from a \$31,500 Parks and Trails NY grant, Carolyn Dunn was hired in June 2019 to fill this role.

# TREASURER'S REPORT - DAN BERRY

### **END OF YEAR ACCOUNT BALANCES**

Cash account balances on June 30, 2020 totaled \$250,245 compared to \$245,023 at the beginning of the year. Of this amount, \$107,623 was restricted to a specific purpose either by the donor or by Board action and \$142,622 was unrestricted. Total net assets for the year increased to \$259,531.





# EDUCATION PROGRAMMING REPORT – NANCY CONWAY

## **Education Programming Report - Nancy Conway**

The Guided School Program's instructor motto is **Flexibility**. Defined as the ability to change without breaking, flexibility is a key trait for successful guiding. Unforeseen events will occur, and how an instructor chooses to proceed makes all the difference. By choosing to be flexible, instructors help children create positive memories of their time outdoors at Five Rivers.

In March an unprecedented event shut down all programming at Five Rivers and flexibility was again embraced. Friends' volunteers, staff, and interns as well as our teammates in DEC, Operations and New York State Industries for the Disabled, Inc, flexed with each new guideline.

Friends staff modified training and program content, and created safety protocols in alignment with DEC, state and federal guidelines. In April, four weeks after the shutdown, Friends and DEC staff provided online trainings for volunteer instructors and interns. Six weeks later Friends held small group trainings on site with the support of DEC, Operations and New York State Industries for the Disabled, Inc. By July, Friends began offering in person public programming and has continued to do so without incident.

Connecting with nature is invaluable, especially in times like these. When your schedule has some flexibility, I hope you'll stop by for a restorative moment at Five Rivers.

# **EDUCATION PROGRAMMING REPORT – NANCY CONWAY**

### PROGRAMMING HIGHLIGHTS: JULY 2019 TO JUNE 2020

• The Guided School Program led 1,228 students accompanied by 223 adult chaperones between September 17, 2019 and March 12, 2020. The shutdown canceled scheduled visits for 2,262 students and 346 adult chaperones in the spring. Dedicated volunteer instructors spent the spring mastering the use of WebEx and attended trainings online.

Bravo instructors!



- The Summer Family Program ran three sessions in July and August with 43 families taking part. Instructors led small groups on adventures in the field, wild garden, forest and stream habitats.
- Talk and Trek themes piqued patrons' interests, doubling registrants. Themes included homestead crafts (fall), a study of Stokes' *A Guide to Nature in Winter (winter)* and Geocaching (early spring).



- Family Fun or "Nature School" was in high demand (28 families) with repeat families filling nearly all slots session after session. Why so popular? Because indoor and outdoor activities were developmentally appropriate, promoting a sense of success for each child and adult partner.
- Parks & Trails NY (PTNY) recognized Friends as a leader in successfully providing in person public programming during COVID 19. Friends of Five Rivers will present the processes and protocols used to safely provide this programming in a November webinar hosted by PTNY for Friends groups throughout New York.
