HOW TO DRESS

- Shoes or sneakers (not sandals) are required footwear.
- Long pants are suggested to protect against poison ivy and insect bites.
- A hat is recommended.
- Bring rain gear if the weather looks threatening.
- You may also bring a small backpack.
- For Summer Nature Weeks (ages 2-8), Friday sessions will be spent wading in the stream. Old sneakers and shorts are more appropriate for these days. Footwear must be worn by all participants in the stream. Water shoes must have a back strap and toes must be covered.

WATER

All participants should bring water.
⇒ Snacks are encouraged.

INSECT REPELLENT

Insects are attracted to strong smelling shampoos, soaps, and sweet-smelling snacks. Your first line of defense should be to the elimination of all strong aromas.

Some repellents are extremely toxic. These repellents on hands or skin can be harmful to water critters or other animals you may handle. Consider using natural, plant-based repellents. Anything stronger, you may not be allowed to handle specimens or be in the stream.
